MAILBOX AND MAINTENANCE



One of the most common issues regarding upkeep of Long's Pond Estates is the condition of mailboxes and/or posts. Unfortunately, the original mailboxes put up with our homes were not constructed with materials to last. The Board of Directors worked with the management company to send out notices for mailbox upkeep. Please take a moment to take a look at your mailbox and address issues that might result in a letter from the management company. Upkeep of our homes include e.g. cleaning of mildew, replacement of rotted or material, painting, damaged etc. Several homeowners have mentioned being successful at removing the mold/mildew using a simple bleachwater mixture with a scrubber. There are also local businesses who will provide their pressure washing services for a reasonable price and within each household's budget.

In addition to your mailbox check, please take a moment to inspect the outside of homes for any mold/mildew build-up.

PET CARE

This Cat Age Conversion Chart will help you understand the physiological changes your cat encounters as she ages, as well as anticipate and forestall age-related health problems before they start.

Please keep in mind that several factors will determine the comparative physical condition of cats at any given age, including heredity, diet, veterinary care, and whether a cat is kept indoors only or allowed outdoors unsupervised.

In addition, as cats age, they may lose their sense of taste and smell, turning them into picky eaters. Feed mature adult cats smaller, more frequent meals and warm their wet food to help stimulate their senses and improve appetite. The combination of regular checkups with your veterinarian, well-balanced nutrition and routine exercise appropriate for your cat's age will help ensure a long and healthy life.
